High sensitivity:

High sensitivity is a temperamental trait that characterizes about 20-30% of the population. Research confirms that highly sensitive people process information and stimuli from their environment more strongly (intensely) and deeply than others. These people are more sensitive to both positive and negative experiences.

For whom?

- ▶ Learners - at career choice stage, job seekers/ changers, long-term unemployed
- ▶ School career counsellors, academic counsellors, people representing labour market institutions
 - ▶ HR departments in enterprises
- ▶ Institutional partners: Labour Market Institutions, Career Offices, schools, employers.
